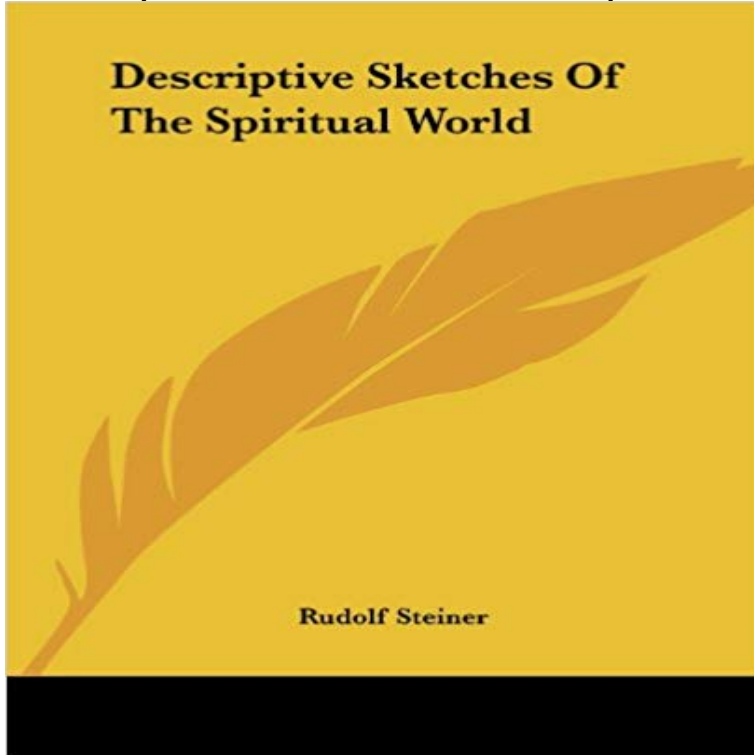


Descriptive Sketches Of The Spiritual World
