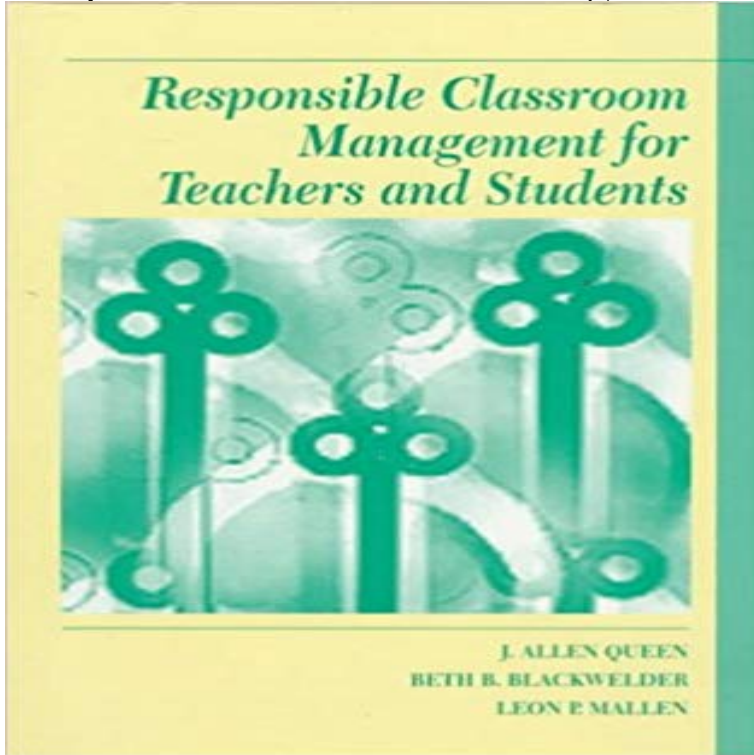


Responsible Classroom Management for Teachers and Students
