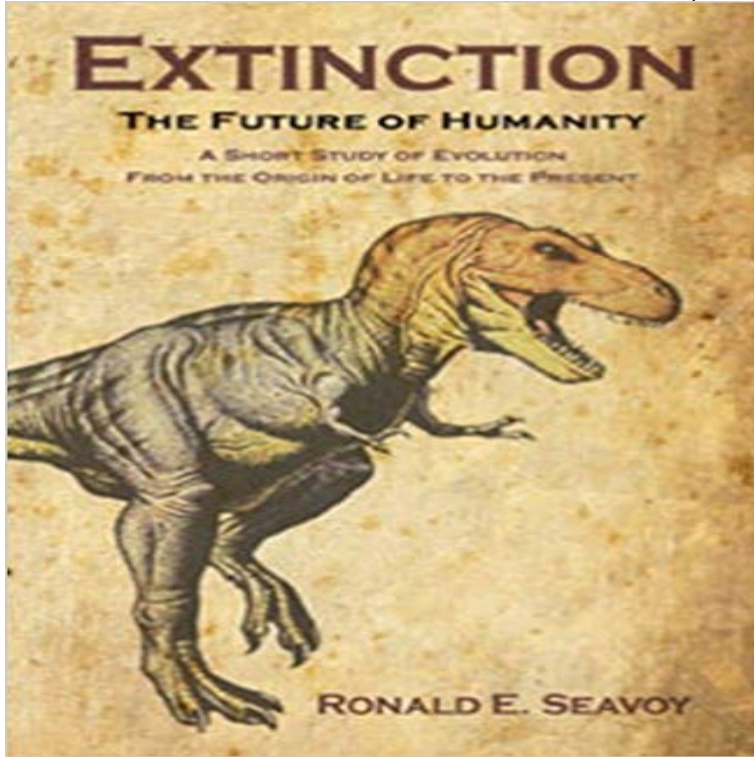


# Extinction: The Future of Humanity
