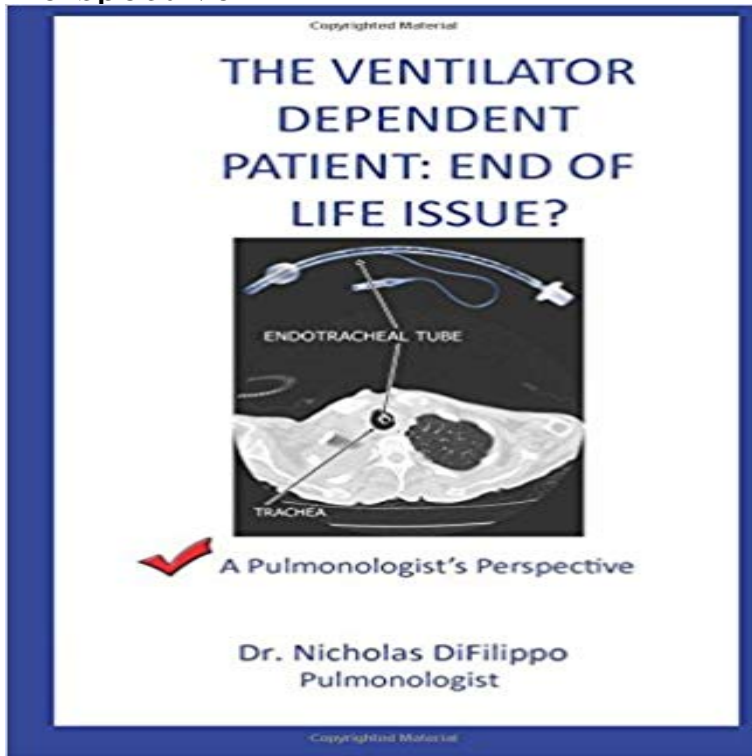


# The Ventilator Dependent Patient: End Of Life Issue?: A Pulmonologists Perspective
