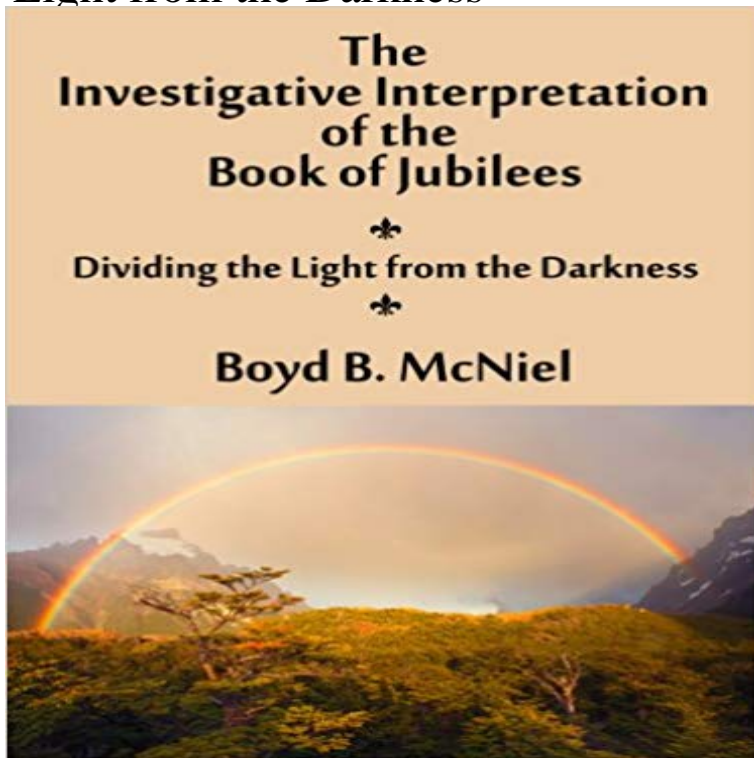


The Investigative Interpretation of the Book of Jubilees: Dividing the Light from the Darkness
